- Day 5 – 16th Jun 2016: Sai Gon departure (B)

Detailed Itinerary:

Day 1 – 13th Jun 2016: Sai Gon arrival

You will be greeted at the airport and transferred to the city centre. In the afternoon, we make the half day city tour: the old colonial quarters, the central post office, market, outside the **Reunification Palace, City Hall, Notre Dame Cathedral**. Walk in **Chinatown Cholon, Binh Tay Market, Thien Hau Temple and pagoda Giac Lam** where still live a dozen monks. Discovery of crafts: making lacquer. Overnight in hotel.

Day 2 – 14th Jun 2016: Sai Gon – Tay Ninh – Cu Chi Tunnels(B,L)

Take this day tour to see one of North Vietnam's most iconic structures. You will head to the **Great Holy See Temple at Tây Ninh**.

The Great Holy See Temple was built in 1926 as the first temple and Holy See of the Cao Dai faith. Considered one of the most remarkable structures in all of Southeast Asia, it acts as the headquarters of this unique sect, which is a hybrid of Buddhism, Christianity and Confucianism. Look out for the all-seeing holy eye, the official symbol of Cao Dai, located above the temple entrance. Then attend the extravagant midday ceremony to witness how the Cao Dai followers conduct daily mass. Arrival in Sai Gon in the late afternoon. Overnight in hotel.

Continue to **Cu Chi Tunnels**. After an introductory video, viewing various mantraps, the remains of an American tank and numerous bomb craters, you will spend the next hour exploring the maze of tunnels to see how the Viet Cong survived in this underground network. Back to Sai Gon in the afternoon. Overnight in hotel.

Day 3 – 15th Jun 2016: Sai Gon – My Tho – Sai Gon(B,L)

The Mekong Delta is the southernmost region of Vietnam and is often referred to as the rice bowl of Vietnam as it produces three crops of rice per year. The fertile **Mekong Delta** is also famous for its tropical fruits and flowers. The Delta area marks the end of a 4,500 km journey made by the Mekong River after having traveled through six countries. Traditional transportation in the Delta is by boat along a vast network of canals and channels. Boating along these canals and visiting the floating markets always proves to be a fascinating and rewarding experience for all visitors.

You will leave HCMC to head for lush My Tho, where you will **cruise on a private boat** through the green vegetation of the canals to an orchard.

Transfer back to Sai Gon in the afternoon. Overnight in hotel.

Day 4 – 16th Jun 2016: Sai Gon departure (B)

Free time for your shopping until transfer to the airport to take your flight off.
